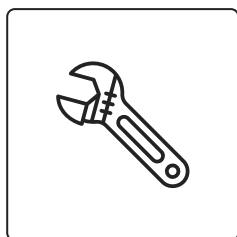

TOOLS & PARTS FOR INSTALLATION

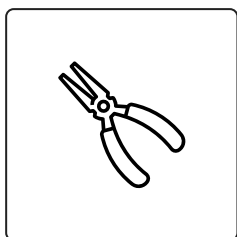
For installation, you'll need an adjustable spanner and pliers to help secure and tighten your EZYFIX tapware.

Inside the box you'll find the Modern Lever Spout, Modern Lever Handles, cartridge assemblies, spindle extenders, nipples, thread tape, anti-vandal spanner, locking nuts, and O rings.

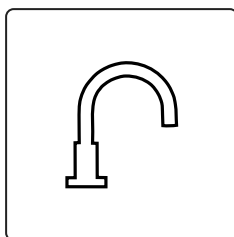
To remove your old tapware, you may also need a pointed nose pliers, basin wrench and a rubber strap wrench to help loosen and access tightly fitted or hard-to-reach components.



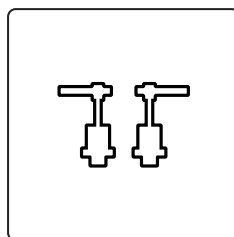

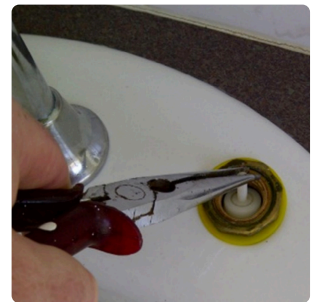
STEP-BY-STEP INSTALLATION

1

Remove old taps and spout

1. Turn off the water at your meter and drain the system by opening the lowest hot and cold outlets in your home (usually the bath taps).
2. Remove the old buttons, handles, flanges, spindles, and jumper valves. A rubber strap wrench is ideal for loosening tight dress flanges.
3. Undo the old spout locknut underneath the basin, then twist and pull the spout free from above. Cut out the existing O-ring on the breech piece and replace it with the new O-ring supplied with your EZYFIX taps.

EZYtip: If the locknut is difficult to loosen, secure it with a spanner underneath while gently twisting the spout from above to break it free.

Prepare your new EZYFIX taps

1. Disassemble your new Modern Lever taps with the anti-vandal spanner provided in the pack. It is **CRUCIAL** that you separate the Locking Nut from the Ceramic Cartridge.

EZYtip: Place the components down in order of removal to make reassembly simple.

2. Check to see the depth of your existing tap seat. If it is really deep, then this is where you would install the spindle extension.

Install your new EZYFIX taps

1. Screw in the ceramic cartridge by hand until it reaches the tap seat. Then gently tighten with a spanner at about the same strength you would use to turn off a tap. Place the fibre washer over and then tighten on the lock nut firmly with a spanner.
2. Screw on the tap flange and re-install the discreet locking nut, circlip, handle adaptor, and then handle.

EZYtip: Don't tighten up the handle yet. Wait until you turn on the mains water to set the lever at the angle you want it to be when the taps are off.



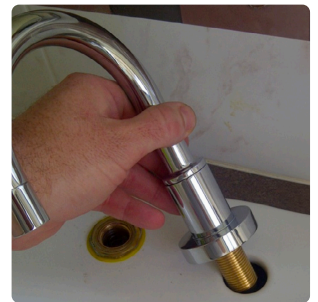
STEP-BY-STEP INSTALLATION

Install your new EZYFIX spout

1. Select the correct sized adaptor, apply thread tape and screw into spout. Must put the thread tape on clockwise.
2. Push on the new spout and re-tighten locknut beneath basin.

EZYtip: Lubricate the O-rings on the existing breach piece nipple with tap lubricant or even olive oil to make assembly easy.

Job Done!

1. Turn on your water supply at the mains then run back inside to turn off your running tap.
2. You can now select what angle you want your levers installed at and then secure them with the anti vandal spanner.
