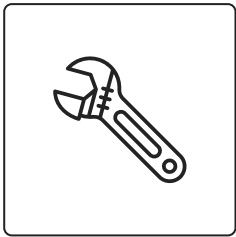
LEVER WALL TAPS

TOOLS & PARTS FOR INSTALLATION

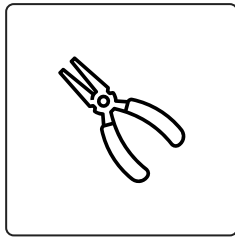
For installation, you'll need an adjustable spanner and pliers to help secure and tighten your EZYFIX tapware.

Inside the box you'll find the Modern Lever Handles, cartridge assemblies, thread extenders, anti-vandal spanner, and locking nuts.

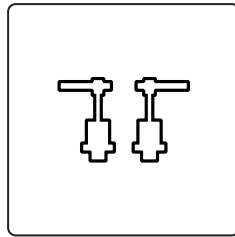
To remove your old tapware, you may also need a pointed nose pliers and a rubber strap wrench to help loosen and access tightly fitted or hard-to-reach components.



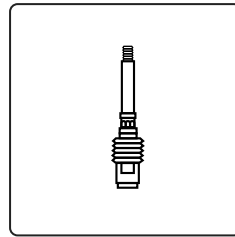

STEP-BY-STEP INSTALLATION

1

Remove old taps

1. Turn off the water at your meter and drain the system by opening the lowest hot and cold outlets in your home (usually the bath taps).
2. Undo the old handle, flange, spindle and make sure you remove the fibre body washer and jumper valve. The old jumper valve may have swollen, so the pointed nose pliers will make removal easier.

EZYtip: The empty EZYFIX packaging is a great way to handle the old fittings as you remove them so as to avoid damage to your bath or your bathroom surface.



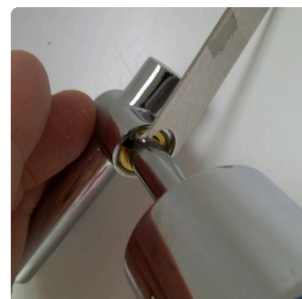

Prepare your new EZYFIX taps

1. Disassemble your new Modern Lever taps with the anti-vandal spanner provided in the pack.

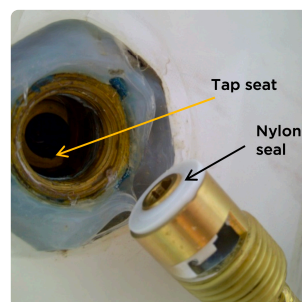
It is CRUCIAL that you separate the Locking Nut from the Ceramic Cartridge.

EZYtip: Place the components down in order of removal to make reassembly simple.



IMPORTANT!

This nylon seal at the base of the ceramic cartridge MUST be able to seal against the existing tap seat. This is why the ceramic cartridge and the locking nut need to be separated prior to installation.



STEP-BY-STEP INSTALLATION

Install your new EZYFIX taps

1. Screw in the ceramic cartridge by hand until it reaches the tap seat. Then gently tighten with a spanner at about the same strength you would use to turn off a tap. Place the fibre washer over and then tighten on the lock nut firmly with a spanner.
2. Screw the PVC thread extender into the tap flange and re-install. Push on the discreet locking nut, circlip, handle adaptor, and then handle.

EZYtip: Don't tighten up the handle yet. Wait until you turn on the mains water to set the lever at the angle you want it to be when the taps are off.

Set the angle of your handles and job done!

1. You can now turn on your water supply at the mains.
2. Turn off your taps if they are running. Select the angle at which you want the lever to be when switched off. Now simply tighten the discreet locking nut with the anti-vandal spanner.
