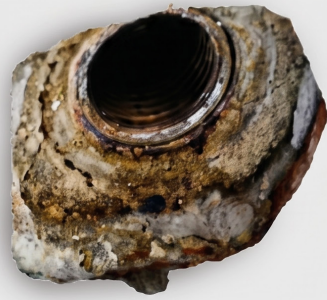

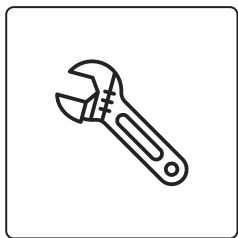
IN-WALL PLUMBING TOO DEEP?

TOOLS FOR INSTALLATION

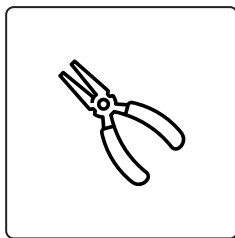
For installation, you'll need an adjustable spanner and pliers to help secure and tighten your EZYFIX tapware.

Inside the box you'll find the Modern Lever Taps, cartridge assemblies, spindle extenders, anti-vandal spanner, and locking nuts.

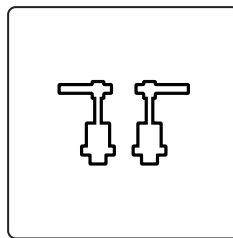
To remove your old tapware, you may also need a clear silicone, cloth, and pliers to help loosen and access tightly fitted or hard-to-reach components.



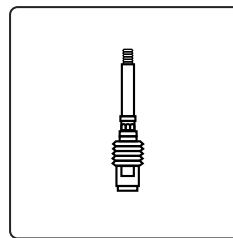

IN WALL PLUMBING TOO DEEP AND YOUR FLANGES WON'T SCREW ON?

This guide provides a solution that can be used on all wall mounted Modern Lever taps.

HERE'S A SOLUTION

The simplest solution is to purchase extra black PVC threaded extenders.

Using PVC extenders for extra height

1. The black PVC extenders are M&F so they can be screwed into each other end to end to achieve extra height when screwed into the wall dress flange.
2. This should now allow you to screw on your wall dress flanges.
3. If not then there is another solution.



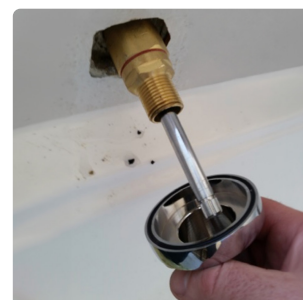
HERE'S ANOTHER SOLUTION

Purchase an EzyFix in-wall ceramic disc seat extender kit.

Using an EzyFix In-Wall Seat Extender Kit

1. Screw the in-wall extension adaptor by hand at first ensuring the fibre body washer is in-place. tighten with the 29mm sized end of our EzyFix tough tube spanner kit.
2. Screw in the cartridge only, don't overtighten.
3. Screw on locknut with fibre body washer and re-dress tapware as per our Tapware instructions.
4. Job done!



NO EXCUSES – 5 YEAR WARRANTY
