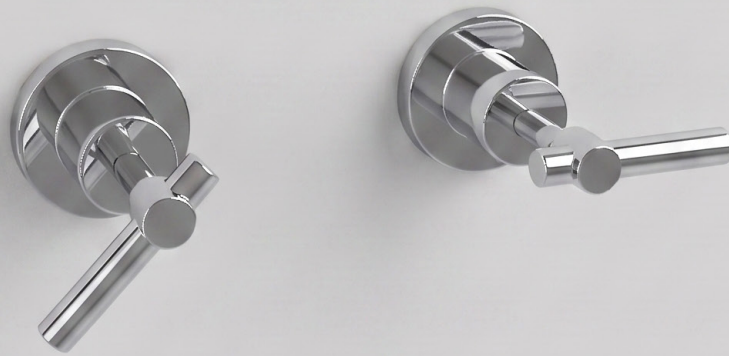

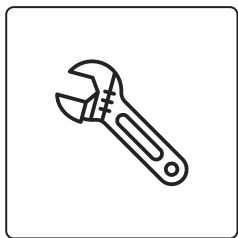
MISALIGNED LEVER TAPS

TOOLS FOR INSTALLATION

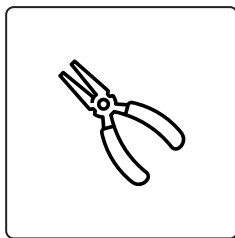
For installation, you'll need an adjustable spanner and pliers to help secure and tighten your EZYFIX tapware.

Inside the box you'll find the Modern Lever Taps, cartridge assemblies, spindle extenders, anti-vandal spanner, and locking nuts.

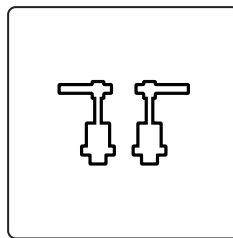
To remove your old tapware, you may also need a clear silicone, cloth, and pliers to help loosen and access tightly fitted or hard-to-reach components.



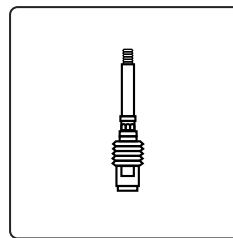

LEVER TAPS DON'T FINISH SQUARE WHEN TURNED OFF?

This guide provides a solution that can be used on both wall and hob mounted modern lever tap sets.

HERE'S A SOLUTION

The simplest solution is to purchase extra black PVC threaded extenders.

Remove tap components

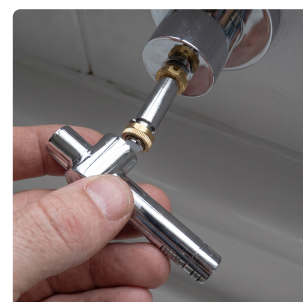
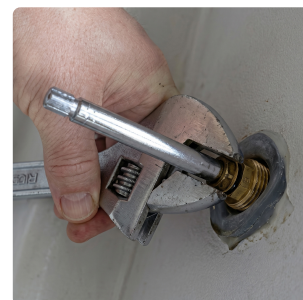
1. Turn off water mains
2. Remove the handle, circlip, O-ring, discreet locknut, dress flange, locking nut, fibre washer, and ceramic cartridge spindle as pictured.

Cartridge adjustment

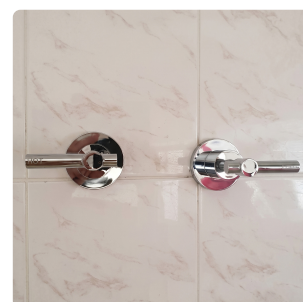
1. Assemble on the hot and cold lever handles only and turn to the off position for both. If water still comes from spout or shower outlet, then tighten a little more. A small amount of water may be coming from around the cartridge in the wall or basin, this is okay as when you install the fibre washer and locknut, this will stop the leak.
2. Now tighten the hex nut on the ceramic cartridge until your handles are square.

Job done!

Now re-assemble the taps. Job done!
